




## SETTING UP A JUSTGIVING PAGE

Creating your own Fabulous Summer Tea Party JustGiving page is easy to do and it's a brilliant way of raising money as your guests, or those who can't make it, can simply donate online.

Below is a helpful guide on how to set up your JustGiving Page, as well as some handy tips on how to get the best out of it.

1. You can set up your page to be linked to our Horatio's Garden JustGiving site by simply visiting [www.justgiving.com/horatios-garden](http://www.justgiving.com/horatios-garden) and clicking the orange 'Fundraise for Us' button in the top right-hand corner.



2. Follow JustGiving's easy process to create your own page.
3. Choose whether you're taking part in the event, celebrating an occasion in support of the Fabulous Summer Tea Party, fundraising in memory or do your own thing. You can select 'Add your own' at the bottom of the page if what you'd like to say isn't listed. You can then tell us more about your activity.
4. Choose your web address. This is the link you will share when asking your guests and supporters to donate. This can be personalised with your name or event title.
5. Click 'Create your page.'
