Horatio's Garden Scotland Design Concept

Design

Designed by award-winning garden designer, James Alexander-Sinclair, the garden is divided into six distinct spaces, each with a different purpose and designed to stimulate different senses – sight, smell, touch and all providing a sense of wellbeing. The courtyard is at the heart of the unit and is accessible to everyone to enjoy. There is a woodland garden overlooked by the wards to encourage wildlife into the garden, a play garden for children who are visiting relatives in the unit and a physiotherapy garden which is functional as well as beautiful.

Courtesy of Hartley Botanic, there is a magnificent greenhouse and a greenhouse garden which houses the volunteer HQ and is surrounded by raised beds and areas for horticultural therapy sessions. The scented garden is planted with carefully chosen shrubs growing around a stunning 'Coccolith' sculpture, donated by Brewin Dolphin which formed part of its award winning 2016 Chelsea Flower Show garden.

A public garden provides a beautiful space for a moment of quiet reflection for people visiting the main hospital.

Planting

Planting of the half acre garden was completed by September 2016. New plant varieties are added, as directed by James during his visits each season, so the design is continually evolving.

The garden is maintained by a head gardener and a team of volunteers with the assistance of patients with spinal cord injuries.
